
Even then, we could feel the presence of God moving and shaping us, but we had no idea what He was doing or what He would do in the years to come.





Matthew 21: 1-5

As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage on the Mount of Olives, Jesus sent two disciples, 2 saying to them, “Go to the village ahead of you, and at once you will find a donkey tied there, with her colt by her. Untie them and bring them to me. 3 If anyone says anything to you, say that the Lord needs them, and he will send them right away.”

This took place to fulfill what was spoken through the prophet: “Say to Daughter Zion, ‘See, your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey, and on a colt, the foal of a donkey.’

Genesis 49:19

Gad will be attacked by a band of raiders, but he will attack them at their heels.

Matthew 8: 28-34

When he arrived at the other side in the region of the Gadarenes, two demon-possessed men coming from the tombs met him. They were so violent that no one could pass that way. “What do you want with us, Son of God?” they shouted. “Have you come here to torture us before the appointed time?”

Some distance from them a large herd of pigs was feeding. The demons begged Jesus, “If you drive us out, send us into the herd of pigs.”

SESSION 4

Nehemiah 1: 1-4

The words of Nehemiah son of Hakaliah:

In the month of Kislev in the twentieth year, while I was in the citadel of Susa, Hanani, one of my brothers, came from Judah with some other men, and I questioned them about the Jewish remnant that had survived the exile, and also about Jerusalem.

They said to me, “Those who survived the exile and are back in the province are in great trouble and disgrace. The wall of Jerusalem is broken down, and its gates have been burned with fire.” When I heard these things, I sat down and wept. For some days I mourned and fasted and prayed before the God of heaven.

Joel 2: 1-9

Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill. Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of the Lord is coming. It is close at hand—a day of darkness and gloom, a day of clouds and blackness. Like dawn spreading across the mountains a large and mighty army comes, such as never was in ancient times nor ever will be in ages to come.

Before them fire devours, behind them a flame blazes. Before them the land is like the garden of Eden, behind them, a desert waste— nothing escapes them. They have the appearance of horses; they gallop along like cavalry. With a noise like that of chariots they leap over the mountaintops, like a crackling fire consuming stubble, like a mighty army drawn up for battle.

At the sight of them, nations are in anguish; every face turns pale. They charge like warriors; they scale walls like soldiers. They all march in line, not swerving from their course. They do not jostle each other; each marches straight ahead. They plunge through defenses without breaking ranks. They rush upon the city; they run along the wall. They climb into the houses; like thieves they enter through the windows.

Isaiah 37: 31-32

Once more a remnant of the kingdom of Judah will take root below and bear fruit above. For out of Jerusalem will come a remnant, and out of Mount Zion a band of survivors. The zeal of the Lord Almighty will accomplish this.

So justice is driven back, and righteousness stands at a distance; truth has stumbled in the streets, honesty cannot enter.

The vast hall was filled with the sound of clanging armour. Warriors dressed for battle, helmets tucked into their arms, swords hung securely in their sheath at each side, all standing to attention as an army awaiting the instruction from the commander.

I looked around but couldn't quite believe I was standing watching this scene. Hundreds, thousands stood before the throne, each one summoned by name.

"Summoned to the throne room for such a time as this" was the call. I glanced over the hall, twelve marble pillars lined the room, six on each side. The ceiling was submerged in a presence of a white cloud of glory. Red velvet curtains with gold trimmings draped the six huge windows. It gave one a sense that you were in the king's palace.

There, at the front under the mist, was His throne. The shafts of lightning protruded from around the throne room and precious stones of emerald, jasper and Sardis emanated from the walls. Like a synchronized action, with every head bowed, the room fell to their knees and the sound echoed through the halls.

Like a voice of many rushing waters and of thundering, the king spoke, "Arise" men of valour it is time!

Every soldier stood to his feet and a hush came over the room.... I looked up. I couldn't hold back, I couldn't hold back my words, they just spilled out, ...MY King, My King... I was in awe; I was in awe of His gallant majesty, and the power of His authority.

Little did I know, all those that stood around were not just men, but women even children!

I watched as the King beckoned to someone at the far end of the hall.

We all waited transfixed as the sound of footsteps echoing with every stride, drew nearer and nearer. To everyone's amazement, there standing clad in armour stood the smallest warrior in the room.

This ruddy looking young lad stood with head bowed, before the ancient one. Jesus smiled, stooped down, stretched out His hands and lifted the boy's head gently.

His word seemed to flow like a cool breeze over the young lad, though none heard his voice. I watched as his mouth moved, craving every word that was being spoken just for this young one.

As His lips stopped moving, the young lad was covered in a blanket of the Kings aroma, circled with a power of glory.

Out of the glory, The Father, Son and Holy Spirit overshadowed him and this little one stood suddenly as a giant before our eyes....

The young lad turn to leave as if commanded to do so... and as he did, suddenly, emerging from all corners of the room, young children began to follow him, all dressed for battle, and there, trailing behind each of them, were their robes soaked in blood.

As if someone turned back on the sound, the commander in Chief stood up and cried out. " A Generation of Martyrs! Martyrs for the kingdom"!

We all watched as they eventually disappeared from view...

Then the word came, "the time is now, I'm awakening and raising up my remnant in the earth. They're battle ready, armed and dangerous against the enemy. They're a people of every tribe and every tongue, old and young.

I'm sending you to the corners of the earth to release a blaze never seen before. I am stirring up the mighty men of war to take their place.

Hold back the enemy, break their necks, uproot, pull down, push against his plans, destroy his strong holds, take the land!"

PRAYER FOR AN AWAKENING IN OUR FAMILIES


“They said to me, “The remnant there in the province who survived the captivity are in great distress and reproach, and the wall of Jerusalem is broken down and its gates are burned with fire.”

iCWN is a UK registered Christian charity dedicated to promoting change in the lives of underprivileged and entrapped women around the world.

The Network is dedicated to helping women across the world who are impoverished, enslaved or trapped by the sex trade, domestic violence or substance abuse.

As part of our commitment to working with women and helping them to grow in the spiritual walk with God, ICWN is an umbrella charity with several project arms that target specific areas of women's lives.

Each year, iCWN holds a variety of events in the UK ranging from 1 day seminars on healing, deliverance and marriage building to weekend prayer retreats and more.

VISION OF THE PRAYER

In these last days God is raising up a remnant on the earth. Those who will stand in the gap for the nations, cities, families and for His church. The **midnight watch** is crucial to taking up the position on the wall in the night watches, to standing firm and warring in the spirit.

"I was invited by a friend to join the WoW midnight prayer vigil, even though I wasn't part of the UK congregation; in fact, I was in a whole other country. It felt like being part of a power movement - the power of the Holy Spirit. I was not new to prayer or even communal prayer, but WoW took it to another level. I see the effect of these prayers as both a battering ram and a spray of arrows - working against the enemy by both breaking things down and hitting things that are scattered about to derail the people of God. They also act to uplift the body of Christ; planting and building up according to God's purposes. Regardless how long I was able to be on, it was always a powerful time and I believe that God called every single one strategically, and by name. The experience I've had with WoW has encouraged me to go deeper in my personal prayer life as well, and I know that God will continue to do a great work in each one and as a collective, as we continue to both press in and surrender."

I learnt to become friends with the Holy Spirit and allow Him space to speak as well as share my thoughts, feelings and challenges to Him. The Lord has given me a burden for prayer so attending and at times leading an iPG has been a central part of my spiritual growth. Attending each week has definitely given me an opportunity to grow in understanding of general prayer, intercession and in exercising a prophetic gifting. Each time we meet, our time has been filled with the presence of God and as a result we have been greatly encouraged and strengthened even at times when we have felt physically and spiritually tired.
